

Watch Out! Roads Flood during Storms

During a storm, watch out for road flooding. Some areas are lower than others, leading to the pooling of water. Standing water can be deeper than it appears. Drive with caution!



Road Safety:

- 1) For Hurricanes or Tropical Storms, consider evacuating early. Long delays crossing the Swing Bridge can lead to the accumulation of water on the roads.
- 2) Small cars, or cars low to the ground, should pay extra attention to standing pools of water. Drive around pools of water to avoid getting stuck.
- 3) Drive slowly and give cars in front of you extra space. Driving too fast could lead to hydroplaning.
- 4) Maintain proper air pressure in tires.
- 5) Tune in to your radio to stay informed of approaching storms.
